Women of Distinction Incorporated ("WOD") based in Georgia, started its work in the underserved communities of Atlanta and its suburbs in 2005. This laid the foundation for the organization becoming incorporated as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation in 2010.

WOD empowers women and their families by connecting them to essential community resources, including healthcare, education, mentorship, and success tools. Each year, WOD impacts thousands of lives through its core programs:

**Mentorship**: Youth programs feature initiatives like Coding (in partnership with NCBW100), Interview Prep (presentation skills, Dress for Success, scholarships), and "A Circle of Women" serving more than 100 mentees from elementary to college aged students in Atlanta

**Health:** The Annual Health and Wellness Fair delivers free health education, screenings, and resources to the community. With many Americans lacking health insurance, WOD's health fair—established in 2009—partners with healthcare organizations to address chronic conditions prevalent in underserved areas

**Veterans:** The "Combat Boots to Stilettos" program helps female veterans transition from military to civilian life, offering mentorship and life skills to support their successful adjustment

**International:** The Young African Leaders' Initiative (YALI) Leadership Program, in partnership with Clark Atlanta University, brings young African adults to the U.S. each year who participant in various events to network and learn best practices in business from top executives, equipping them with tools to share in Africa

**Advocacy:** WOD At Work - Know Your Rights and VOTE! The mission is to empower individuals, especially young adults, within deprived communities, with the knowledge, resources, and support needed to exercise their voting rights. We are committed to fostering civic engagement, advancing accessibility, and ensuring that every voice is heard and counted in our democracy.

WOD also maintains ongoing specialty outreach efforts such as Mother's Day visits with gift baskets for mothers and children in shelters, an annual Healthy Breakfast with Santa Claus, hosted in partnership with the Men of Distinction-Atlanta, LLC, where new toys are distributed to inner-city children, and the signature Scholarship and Empowerment Luncheon, raising money for educational scholarships for young women aspiring higher education and also honoring outstanding female leaders for their work and achievements in the community.
